

THE STORY

THE CAPTIVATING WATERS OF OKOBOJI

have attracted visitors for many generations with an allure strong enough to make lifetime residents out of some and frequent returners out of everyone else. Around 1884, one such visitor was a man named W.S. Wilson who, together with his sons, would create Wilson Boat Works and later acquire the adjoining and iconic Okoboji Store. For nearly 90 years and across three generations, the Wilson Family would be the careful custodians of the southern-most shore of Okoboji, providing supplies and a place to meet and socialize. They delivered groceries by horse-drawn wagon, built boats bearing their name, serviced and rented boats and dock space, drove passenger steamboats, operated the swing bridge, and yes, did a little fishing.

the divide between Arnolds Park and Okoboji rotated or "swung" to allow steamboat passage between lakes. The Sioux City, Des Moines, Iowa, Hiawatha, Ben Lennox, and Queen were among a fleet of boats providing


a mode of transportation as well as a form of entertainment.

Early bridges which spanned

The arrival of the Milwaukee railroad linked Okoboji to the rest of the world and ignited tourism. The convergence of rail, road, and water traffic made the Okoboji Store ideally situated to procure supplies and catch upon local gossip.









Iceologist, naturalist, outdoorsman, consummate fisherman, Zeke Wilson. Though Zeke operated the Boat Livery beneath the Okoboji Store, he was also known as the official record keeper of "ice in" and "ice out". Local lore had it that he even had an "in" with Mother Nature.

■ In 1926, Fred Wilson acquired the Chris Craft franchise and introduced Okoboji to some of the finest hulls ever built out of mahogany.

A CENTURY after the arrival of W.S. Wilson, the lake would lure another family to her shores. In 1988, the Mau Family would acquire Wilson Boat Works (now Mau Marine) and, as fate would have it, eventually add to it the adjoining Okoboji Store property. Once again operated by siblings (sisters this time) the operation rents, sells, and services boats, and, perhaps most importantly, provides a place for residents and visitors to meet and socialize. Oh, and by the way, the fishing's still pretty good too.
